Reha N. Tandogan is a senior member of Cankaya Orthopaedics, Ankara, Turkey a 15 surgeon private group specializing in joint preserving surgery and arthroplasty and is the Chairman of the Dept. of Orthopedics & Traumatology, Halic University, Istanbul. His main focus is arthroscopic and reconstructive surgery of the knee, including multi-ligament injuries, cartilage repair, orthobiologics, osteotomies, primary and revision knee arthroplasty & robotic joint replacement.

Dr. Tandogan is the Past Chair of EKA (European Knee Associates) section of ESSKA (European Society of Sports Traumatology, Knee Surgery & Arthroscopy). He is also the Associate Editor of the KSSTA (Knee Surgery, Sports Traumatology, Arthroscopy) Journal. Dr. Tandogan has been serving on the Scientific committee of EFORT since 2022.

He has served as the President of the Turkish Society of Sports Traumatology. He is a former board member and an active instructor in the Turkish Society of Sports Traumatology, Arthroscopy & Knee Surgery.

Dr. Tandogan is the author of 1 English and 10 Turkish books on knee surgery & sports traumatology. He has published 87 scientific articles in international journals and 76 articles in the Turkish literature (h-index 30). Dr. Tandogan is very active in teaching and education, he lectures extensively in national and international meetings, regularly organizes cadaver courses and symposia.







Octav Russu is a distinguished Senior Orthopedic Surgeon renowned for his expertise in knee surgery (including ligament reconstruction and patellar instability) and hip and knee joint replacement, with a specialization in sports medicine. As an Orthopaedics and Traumatology Lecturer at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Tg. Mureş, he actively pursues research in structured surfaces for biomedical applications, particularly through electrochemical anodization.

Russu holds the position of President of the Romanian Society of Arthroscopy and Sports Trauma (SRATS) from 2024 to 2026 and plays a pivotal role in organizing conferences and courses under the auspices of the Romanian Society of Orthopedics and Traumatology (SOROT) and SRATS, including the International Knee Course Tg-Mures with ESSKA patronage. He has authored over 70 scientific papers published in national and international journals and presented more than 90 papers at prestigious scientific meetings worldwide. Additionally, Russu serves as a Journal Reviewer for notable publications such as Knee Surgery Sports Traumatology Arthroscopy (KSSTA), Journal of Experimental Orthopedics (JEO), and Acta Medica Marisiensis.

His career is marked by significant fellowship experiences, including the ESSKA Fellowship in 1999 and subsequent fellowships in 2011 and 2015, focusing on knee surgery, arthroscopy, and knee arthroplasty. Russu has been recognized with honors such as the 2011 Bologna Professor Award from the Romanian Student Organizations National Alliance (ANOSR) and memberships in prestigious organizations like the European Knee Associates (EKA). He has also held key roles in ESSKA committees, including the U45 Committee and as Chairman from 2018 to 2020.







"Prof. Dr Thomas Tischer is an orthopaedic and trauma surgeon with special expertise in open and arthroscopic knee and shoulder surgery.

He studied medicine at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU) in Munich. Afterwards he trained at the LMU Munich and the Technical University of Munich (TUM) with special emphasis on orthopaedics sport surgery (Prof. Imhoff).

Additionally he received a short fellowship at the University of Pittsburgh. He wrote his doctoral thesis about the effects of shock wave therapy on bone and tendon tissue in 2002 and his professoral thesis (habilitation) on tissue engineering of tendon and meniscus tissue in 2009. In 2010 he was appointed full professor at the University of Rostock and worked as head of orthopaedic sport surgery there until June 2021. Since then, he is head of orthopaedic and trauma surgery at the Waldkrankenhaus in Erlangen, Germany.

His scientific work deals with basic science research concerning tendon, meniscus and cartilage regeneration/tissue engineering as well as minimal invasive surgical techniques, with over 175 publications currently listed in PubMed. For his work on tissue engineering of the anterior cruciate ligament he received the AGA Don Joy award in 2006. Prof. Tischer is the President of the German-speaking Society in Orthopaedic and Traumatologic Sports Medicine (GOTS) since 2022.

He is also chairman of the ESSKA ACL revision working group and Scientifc Chair for ESSKA congress in Prague 2026 and received the ESSKA-AOSSM Fellowship in 2017. He is also Associate Editor of KSSTA and SOT."







Alper Kaya, M.D. Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery Acibadem Altunizade Hospital, Istanbul, Turkey

Dr. Alper Kaya is a distinguished orthopaedic surgeon specializing in knee surgery, with expertise in sports traumatology and arthroplasty. He currently serves as President of the Turkish Sports Traumatology Society and is recognized as an Accredited Teacher by the European Society of Sports Traumatology, Knee Surgery and Arthroscopy (ESSKA). Dr. Kaya completed his medical education at Istanbul University Istanbul School of Medicine and residency at Baskent University School of Medicine, Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology. He further honed his skills as a Clinical Research Fellow at the University of Pittsburgh, focusing on knee surgery and sports medicine under the mentorship of Professors Freddie Fu and Christopher Harner. With a wealth of clinical experience, Dr. Kaya has contributed significantly to the field through numerous publications, presentations, and leadership roles in national and international orthopaedic societies.





With over 25 years of experience in Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology, Dr. Prieto Deza currently serves as Head of Orthopedic Surgery at the General Hospital of Menorca, Spain, and leads the Orthopaedic Surgery Department at Juaneda Healthcare Network.

He obtained his medical licensure from Santiago de Compostela University and completed his specialization at "Juan Canalejo" Hospital Complex, La Coruña. His expertise includes knee, shoulder, and ankle surgeries, with advanced training in sports medicine and shoulder surgery in the USA and Europe. Dr. Prieto Deza is actively involved in teaching and has held instructional roles for the Spanish Arthroscopy Association (AEA).

He has contributed significantly to the field through his extensive professional memberships, including being President of ABCOT (Balearic Society of Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology) from 2024 to 2026. Dr. Prieto Deza was also President of AEA from 2022 to 2024, where he directed educational programs and promoted advancements in arthroscopic surgery. His dedication to advancing orthopedic care is underscored by his participation in international conferences and courses, fostering knowledge exchange and innovation in the field.
